### From the Community Spiritual Director —

Dear Ones,

Sometimes we don't know how to respond to people who question our faith. We don't always have the right response on the tip of our tongues. But we all know that Jesus is alive and living in the midst of us through the power and presence of the Holy Spirit within us. So don't get ruffled. Remember this response.

Rev. Guy McGraw, a pastor from Texas, tells a story about a gathering at the University of Chicago Divinity School. An atheist lecturer came as a guest speaker to the school to address a large assembly of students during a lunchtime picnic. While the students ate their packed lunches, the gentleman started his program trying to prove that there is no truth to the resurrection. He quoted various scholars and books trying to prove his point.

After listening for over an hour, a young man stood up to question the guest speaker. While speaking to him he started munching on an apple. In between bites, the young seminarian asked the lecturer to please answer one question for him. The student noted that he hadn't read any of the books that had been referenced nor had he heard of any of the scholars. As he finished swallowing the last delicious bite of his juicy apple he asked the guest, if the apple he just finished had been sweet or bitter. The lecturer said he wouldn't know since he wasn't the one to eat the apple. The young man retorted, "Neither have you tasted my Jesus!" The audience roared with delight and the lecturer left the platform.

Do you remember "tasting Jesus?" Hang on to that memory especially when you're on the spot about what you believe. Even if you feel misunderstood, you know that you know, the truth of the life, death and resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. We live it. We experience it. We have tasted it! As we live into Pentecost let us also proclaim it.

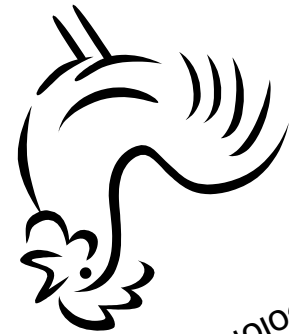
